Joan Payden, CEO of the esteemed money management firm Payden & Rygel, has made a generous pledge of \$1.5 million to endow a professorship at the College of Media, Communication and Information in honor of her late brother, William R. Payden (Jour'57). Bill was a remarkable individual — a journalist, college professor, sports enthusiast, cinephile, professional pianist, world traveler and collector of aviation memorabilia and classic cars. In addition to this new professorship, his legacy includes the William R. Payden Award, an annual \$20,000 prize recognizing outstanding CMCI faculty.

The Payden Professorship will be CMCI's first endowed professorship, marking a significant milestone. Reflecting on her brother, Joan shared; "We were very different, but he was my best friend." This landmark opportunity was secured through the collaborative efforts of CMCI and the Principal Gifts and Strategic Initiatives team.
